

GEORGIA BENEFIT MATRIX (UPDATED W/FY 2024 INCOME GUIDELINES)

STEP 1: Using the applicant's household size and annual income, identify whether the household is in **Level I or Level II** income range.

STEP 2: Using the income range determined in Step 1, find the **main heating fuel type*** of the applicant household and then the corresponding benefit amount.

***Important!** The main fuel type is not always where the benefit is applied.

Example:

A household is in the Level 1 income range. They heat their home with Natural Gas, and bring in both a Gas and Electric bill.

Since they heat their home with **Natural Gas**, the household is eligible for a **Natural Gas benefit** -- even if they opt to apply all of their benefit toward their electric bill.
